On the member page the members can be sorted by their affiliation with the club. On the right side of the screen is a dropdown menu titled “Select a Role.” This will allow sorting by “Mothership Member, Millennial Member , or Allosource Member.” Without sorting, all members will appear on the member list and they are arranged by first name.
