When the Foundation was formed, it was agreed that a certain percentage of the funds raised would go towards developing the corpus of the Foundation and the remainder of the raised funds would be used for Club projects. Within the last three years, the corpus of \$100,000 was achieved so that now all of the funds raised can be used for Club projects.
